Istog/Istok spring is located to the west of the town of Istog/Istok, at an altitude of 523m above sea level. The Istog/Istok spring is a karstic spring with a strong average flow of 3.4 m³/sec. The flow varies significantly in the course of the year. The spring rises in the limestone rock widely found in this region. It is also the source of the Istog/Istok river. Around 100 m below the spring stands the small hydro-electric power plant, with an output of 0.45 MW/h. This spring supplies drinking water to the town of Istog/Istok and some of the surrounding villages. In 2008 Istog/Istok spring was declared to be a protected natural monument of a hydrological and geomorphological character.

The thermal water spring in Banja-Spa is located in the Istog/Istok area, 11 km north-east of Pejë/Peć. Banja spring is a powerful source of natural water flowing from holes in the rock created by the spring itself. Because of heavy precipitation, the spring's point of discharge has changed. The spring has a flow of 17.5 litres per second, and the water temperature is 47°C. According to the balneological classification, the Banja spring (Ilixha) falls in the group classified as hypothermal.
